

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF
THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
SAN GABRIEL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT
HELD ON MARCH 24, 2026**

- CALL TO ORDER** A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County Water District was called to order on Tuesday, March 24, 2026, at 8366 Grand Avenue, Rosemead, California at the hour of 4:00 p.m.
- ROLL CALL** Present at the meeting were General Manager Jim Prior, Finance and Administration Manager Carmen Corona, Assistant General Manager Casey Feilen, Superintendent Carlos Cardona, Directors DeLaTorre, Saucedo, Taylor, Mamdapurkar and District Counsel Koczanowicz. Director Vera was absent.
- AGENDA** Upon motion by Director Taylor and seconded by Director Mamdapurkar, the Board voted to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion passed 4-0
- PUBLIC COMMENT** San Gabriel Vice Mayor, former Director, Eric Chan was present and said hello to everyone.
- MINUTES** Upon motion by Director Taylor, seconded by Director Mamdapurkar, the Board voted to approve the minutes for the meeting of the Board of Directors held on March 10, 2026. Motion passed 4-0.
- DEMANDS** Director Saucedo motioned to authorize an electronic funds transfer from the general account to the revolving account in the amount of \$95,341.33. The motion was seconded by Director Taylor. No questions were asked by the Board. Motion passed on a 4-0 vote.
- DISTRICT COUNSEL REPORT** District Counsel briefed the Board on a U.S. Supreme Court decision in *Olivier v. City of Brandon, Mississippi*. The Plaintiff is a preacher who was cited and charged by the City for violating an Ordinance which prohibited exercise of 1st amendment rights outside of a designated area. He was convicted and paid the applicable fines and penalties. He then filed this action to challenge the validity of the Ordinance and enjoin the City from future enforcements. The Court found the suit to be valid and not subject to dismissal. Court reasoned that Olivier was not trying to overturn the prior charges but prevent future enforcement of the Ordinance. As such the suit was not barred by the *Heck v Humphrey* line of case which prohibit legal challenge in civil court directed to overturn prior criminal convictions.
